**NOTIFICATION**

S.O. 2162(E).- Whereas M/s. Wipro Limited, Pune, a private Organisation of the State of Maharashtra, has proposed under section 3 of the Special Economic Zones Act, 2005 (28 of 2005), hereinafter referred to as the Act, to set up a sector specific Special Economic Zone for information technology and information technology enabled services at Rajiv Gandhi Infotech Park, Phase-II, MIDC, Hinjawadi, District Pune in the State of Maharashtra;

And whereas the Central Government is satisfied that requirements under sub-section (8) of section 3 of the said Act, and other related requirements are fulfilled and it has granted a letter of approval under sub-section (10) of section 3 of the Act for development, operation of the sector specific Special Economic Zone for information technology and information technology enabled services at the said Rajiv Gandhi Infotech Park area on 21<sup>st</sup> August, 2006;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 4 of the Act and in pursuance of rule 8 of the Special Economic Zones Rules, 2006, the Central Government hereby notifies the following area at Rajiv Gandhi Infotech Park, Phase-II, Hinjawadi, Village - Mharunji, Taluka - Mulshi District Pune in the State of Maharashtra, comprising of the plot number and the area given below, as a Special Economic Zone, namely:-

Total Area - 20 hectares.
